March on Washington 50 years later

This week we celebrated the 50th Anniversary of Dr. Martin Luther King's March on Washington for Jobs and Freedom, and his acclaimed "I Have A Dream speech."

President Obama spoke on the struggle for equality among Blacks and Whites in America. Obama said, "Dr. King's speech inspired millions of Americans to fight for a more equal society and rights that people now take for granted." He went on to say, "To dismiss the magnitude of this progress, to suggest, that little has changed, that dishonors the courage, the sacrifice of those who paid the price to march in those years."

"But we would dishonor those heroes as well, to suggest that the work of this nation is somehow complete," he said, calling economic justice "unfinished business" of the civil rights battle.

Salute to Black Women In Politics



Barbara Jordan (1936-1996) represented Texas in the U.S. House of Representatives from 1972-1978 and was the first African-American congresswoman from the deep south.

Carol Mosley Braun (1947-) was elected in 1992 to represent Illinois in the U.S. Senate. She was the first African-American woman elected to the Senate.





Condoleezza Rice (1954-) was the first woman to ever serve as the head of the National Security Council. In 2005 Rice became the first African-American woman to serve as secretary of state.

Susan Rice (1964-) appointed by President Barack Obama in 2009 as the first African-American woman to serve as the U.S. ambassador to the United Nations.
