Positive youth development programs...

The [Changing Life Education Initiative, Inc.](http://www.changinglifeinc.com) is one of the social service programs located in the Stewart Business Center. The program has hired over 100 people each year in the past three years. Its principal goal is to work with youth in and around the Chicago area. The program offers one on one mentoring, job readiness training and homework assistance during the summer and fall education programs. (For a list of all programs visit their website www.changinglifeinc.com) Most programs provide a free hot meal. Students ages six through eighteen are eligible for our programming and students sixteen to twenty four are eligible to participate in the summer employment program. Changing Life Education's program also works with Churches, Businesses, Community Services Agencies and the City of Chicago to feed the homeless on a monthly basis.

The program is headed by CEO/Founder Audrey Johnson. Ms. Johnson initiated the program in 2008. As a native of Chicago she sought and received most of her formal education here. She earned a bachelors degree in History with a minor in Vocal Performance. She completed her Masters Degree in Public Administration. Her extensive background in the community includes involvement with the 4-H Clubs as a youth as well as an adult team leader. Ms. Johnson organized and developed several 4-H Clubs where she lived. She has been involved in community service, community development and youth programming for over 25 years.

Their Mission is:

To establish a safe, nurturing environment where youth and young parents can be positively influenced to progressively increase their academic ability, economic development, social awareness, health awareness and natural creative talents through enhanced academic tutoring, occupational training, life coaching, healthy lifestyle, fine arts instruction and college preparation.
